

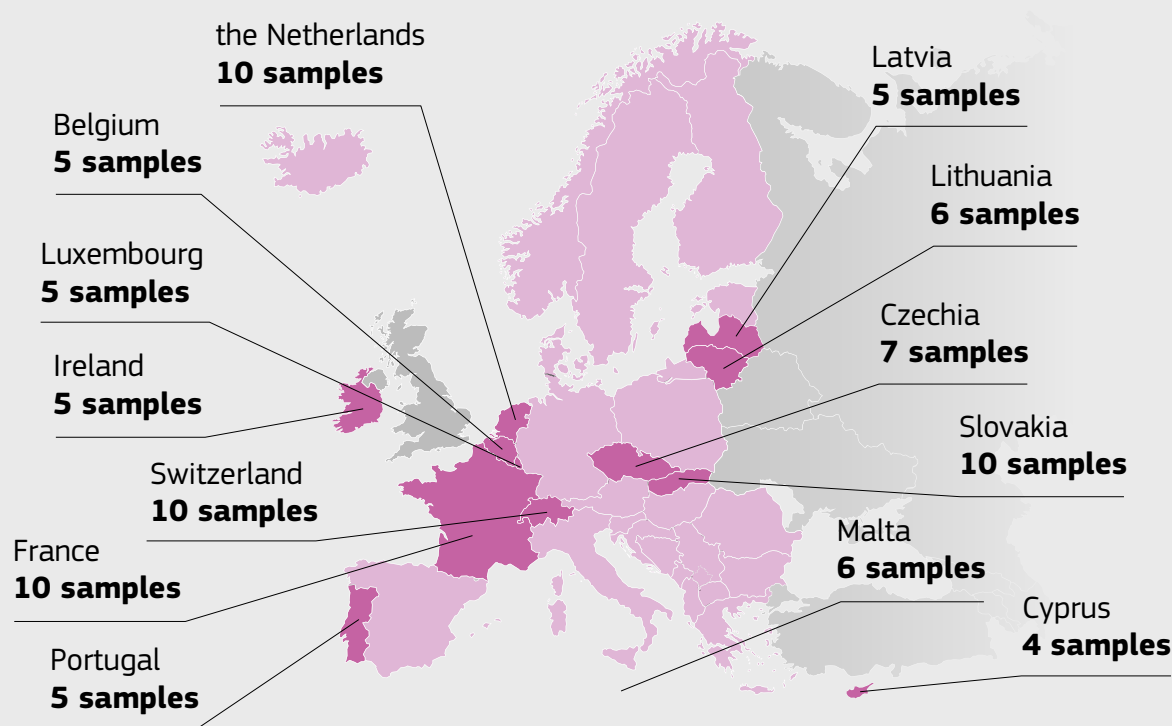


Are radio-controlled toys EU compliant?

An EU-funded campaign tested if radio-controlled (RC) toys for children aged 3-14 can interfere with the performance of other devices

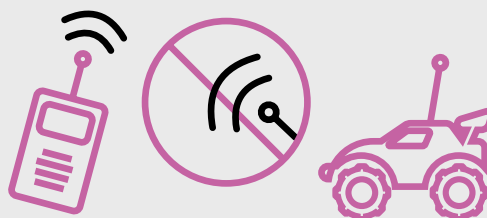
Which products were tested?

88 RC vehicles, walkie-talkies, laptops for children and smart toys sampled online and in stores in 13 countries.

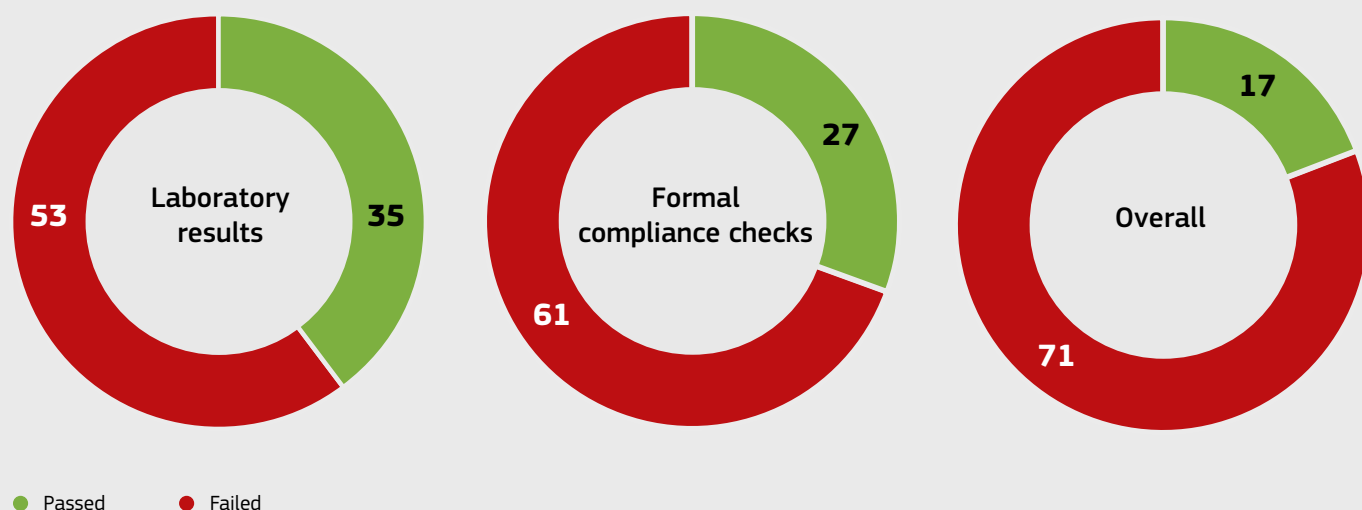


What was tested?

Can the devices cause signal interference, which could disrupt emergency services, critical radio communications and navigation safety?
